This Syrah based Rosé is made in provincial style. It is a pale salmon hue with aromas of grapefruit, peach and coconut. The palate is crisp and light featuring flavors of honeydew melon and grapefruit. Harmonious balance of fruit flavors and acidity makes this wine perfect to enjoy on a warm summer day.

Holmason Vineyard, situated on the north side of Washington's Yakima Valley, lies on the slopes of the Rattlesnake Hills at an elevation of approximately 1,300 feet. This cooler climate location contributes to the production of high-quality grapes with excellent acidity and fruit-forward aromas.

Production: Harvested in the early morning, direct to press, stainless steel fermentation.
