TASTING NOTES

Classic Pinot Noir notes of black cherries, forest floor and allspice flow into this beautifully textured, medium bodied Pinot Noir. Hints of dried strawberry, chocolate and earthy characters present at the mid palate, finishing with lingering notes of limestone and flint to round out the finish. This wine is complex with great balance and a long refined finish.

VINEYARD NOTES

Golden West Vineyard is the largest planting of Pinot Noir in the history of the state of Washington. Sitting on the western edge of the Frenchman Hills and located on the 47th parallel overlooking the Columbia River. A sustainably farmed single vineyard at nearly 1600 feet of elevation. Rooted in ancient limestone, sand and volcanic rock.
